

Communicating in English: Oral Proficiency

During the autumn term of 2017, the Language Workshop will offer an English oral proficiency course for international students. The course is free of charge and does not give any academic credits.

Course aims: This course aims to provide students with basic oral proficiency skills in English, with an emphasis on using English in an academic environment. There will be some pronunciation exercises, but the focus will be on exercises in conversation, discussion, and oral presentations in an academic environment.

Target group: This course is primarily intended for international Masters students who are so-called free movers, and for international PhD students. Students must be registered at Uppsala University in order to take the course. Exchange students may apply for the course but will be placed on a waiting list, and offered a place on the course if there are places vacant at the end of the registration period.

There are no language prerequisites apart from those necessary to be admitted to the university. Students who find it very difficult to understand spoken English are advised to contact the teacher before the course starts.

Course literature: Handouts, which will be distributed during the course.

Examination: Each student who fulfills the course requirements will receive a certificate. Please note that no academic credits will be given for this course.

Course format: This course consists of 8 meetings (every Monday in the late afternoon or evening, 90 minutes).

Attendance is mandatory and students must inform the teacher of any absence in advance. Students who miss more than two meetings, regardless of reason, will not be able to complete the course.

The first meeting will be on Monday, 11 September. All meetings will be on Mondays. The course will run for eight weeks, and the last meeting will be on 30 October.

During the course, each student will make a short oral presentation in English. The oral presentation is mandatory, and required to complete the course.

The focus throughout the course will be on practical uses of English and students will be given practical, individual advice on how to improve their spoken English.

Please note that participants are signed up on a first come first served basis and that the number of participants is limited. Students who take this course cannot take the course Communicating in English: Academic Writing during the same semester.

When signing up for a course, please submit the following information:

- Name of the course you want to sign up for.
- Your own full name and Swedish personal ID number.
- Your main field of study and what degree you are studying for.
- Your native language.
- For Masters students: If you are an exchange student or a free mover.

Fee: There is no fee for this course, but only students at Uppsala University are eligible.
